NSBE-KC seeks to accomplish the NSBE mission through professional networking, knowledge transfer, and community outreach.

Application:

The application will be rated on appearance, verification of information, clarity, and evidence of achievements. The essay should be thoughtfully and clearly written, but succinct. This application must be typed (no handwritten applications will be accepted). Please answer all questions. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.* All documents must be received by the scholarship committee no later than April 1, 2011.

**Applicant must be a member of an under-represented ethnic group, currently in good standing and with senior-level classification at a Kansas City area high school. The minimum GPA requirement is a 2.7/4.0 or equivalent.*

Application Requirements:

- a. One copy of your official transcript
- b. Two letters of recommendation: one from a school faculty/staff member and one from a community member
- c. Resume
- d. Essay (1 page limit, single-spaced, 12pt. font)
- e. Official Application (see below)

Essay Prompt:

The NSBE-KC theme comes from this quote by George Washington Carver “since new developments are the products of a creative mind, we must therefore stimulate and encourage that type of mind in every way possible.” Explain this quote and how it applies to you choosing science, engineering, or technology as a career.
